Please advise your students that the deadline for applications for the F. Gerald Ham and Elsie Ham Scholarship of \$10,000, one of SAA's most substantial awards for graduate archival education, is coming soon: February 28!

Keep in mind these eligibility requirements:

- The student must have successfully completed a <u>minimum of three (3) semester credit</u> <u>hours, or the equivalent</u>, of a course(s) meeting the definition of "core archival knowledge" presented in the Guidelines.
- The scholarship funds must be used to support the graduate archival education of a student who is studying at a United States university program that meets the criteria for graduate education set forth by the Society of American Archivists' <u>Guidelines for a Graduate Program in Archival Studies</u>. (A graduating student may use scholarship funds to pay off student loan debt from his or her graduate archival education.)
- The scholarship funds must be used to support the graduate archival education of a student who is studying at a United States university program that meets the criteria for graduate education set forth by the Society of American Archivists' <u>Guidelines for a Graduate Program in Archival Studies</u>. (A graduating student may use scholarship funds to reimburse incurred school expenses, whether by loan or direct payment, from his or her graduate archival education.)
